What is the Government proposing?

- In Sep 2020 the Govt is planning to introduce RSE (Relationships and Sex Education) to all Infant & Primary schools, which aims to foster acceptance and celebration of different family types, gender identities and relationships
- Parents will **NOT BE ALLOWED** to **withdraw their children** from Relationships Education, as its principles will be embedded throughout the curriculum
- Parents may request an opt out of specific Sex Ed for their children in Primary School
- RSE will be compulsory for secondary school, with only minimal rights for parents

What is happening now?

- Many schools are already using materials which normalise homosexual relationships and transgenderism for all children, as well as the ideologies behind them - for example, through storybooks, and rainbow-themed projects and presentations
- **Some materials encourage introducing very young children to inappropriate sexual material, such as discussion of “self-touching”, the calling out of the names of private body parts, and explicit videos of sexual intercourse (see links below for examples)**
- The powerful and plausible-sounding rationale behind this is the need to prevent bullying of those who are different, and to encourage young people to be true to “who they are” and “how they feel”
- Parents and teachers who question this are already finding themselves isolated and treated as extremists

What are the consequences?

- Children losing their innocence / Sexualisation of children
- Likely increased early sexual activity and experimentation, including LGB sex
- Increased STIs and teenage pregnancies (UK currently highest in Europe)
- Facilitating the grooming of vulnerable children
- Addiction to pornography
- **Confusion about gender identity leading to an increase in medically hazardous and possibly irreversible transgender hormone treatment, causing permanent sterility**
- Confusion about relationships, marriage and family life
- Undermining traditional family values and orthodox religious faith of Christians, Jews and Muslims
- Threat to freedom of speech and belief as those who speak out are accused of “hate”

What are rights for parents?

- Schools must respect the religious and philosophical convictions of parents in education and teaching (Human Rights Act 1998)
- Religious Faith is a protected characteristic under the Equality Act 2010

What are rights for teachers?

- Teachers who do not want to teach material which violate their conscience will have to have this authorised by the headteacher as there is currently no conscience clause regarding this

What can parents do?

- Write to your headteacher asking them to clarify the contents of the curriculum for RSE
- Leaflet parents at the school gate with your concerns (www.schoolgatecampaign.org). Try to find at least five families to write to the school. This is significant enough to cause curriculum review
- Organise a meeting for parents. You can join/start up a Parents Forum (doesn't have to be religious). Find like-minded teachers/governors who will stand with you
- Withdraw your child from Sex Ed lessons
- If the school will not address concerns, change schools/home educate

What can both parents and teachers do?

- Write to your MP
- Invite a speaker from the list of organisations below to address your group
- Encourage your faith community leaders to support those speaking out. If they will not, or if they support RSE, consider changing your place of worship. Set up a prayer network to pray: this is a spiritual battle

- Children as young as 6 are being taught about **masturbation** in 241 schools in Warwickshire (www.dailymail.co.uk/news/article-7490415/Children-young-SIX-given-compulsory-self-touching-lessons.html)
- In the same schools 4-5 year old children are being introduced to transgenderism as a normal way of life and encouraged to shout out the terms, 'anus', 'vagina', 'vulva', 'penis' in class (msc.support/all-about-me)
