

Thank you for praying for my trans-identifying daughter. A few weeks later (and many kind people offering to pray) she seemed to soften, then suddenly lost contact with her two close trans-identifying friends. She stopped wearing her "He/Him" badge and grew her hair. She started making real eye-contact and wearing makeup again. She's now back to fully embracing her femininity and loving it! Thank you to those who prayed!

What happened here seems to be Rapid Onset Gender Dysphoria. Abigail Shrier's book "*Irreversible damage*" describes it as a social contagion that spreads across teenage girls' friendship groups with no prior history of gender dysphoria.

Though grateful about my daughter, I'm very angry with developments in schools. I hear reports and see TikTok videos showing woke teachers promoting their ideological beliefs without accountability. Close to home, my daughter gave me regular updates on the love life of her lesbian teacher, which the children found very exciting.

I was recently asked about an RSE lesson plan from the organisation, Bish, for a friend's 13yr old, which was reluctantly shared by the school.

Children are asked:

- *"Are there any sexual activities you do **not** want to try?"* - ie: encouraging the 13yr olds to actively think about sexual activities they'd be **uncomfortable** with
- *"Would you have unprotected sex?"*
- *"Would you have sex with more than one person?"*

Teachers encourage children to visit Bish - bishuk.com - though some internet filters block it for under-18s.

Our children are having their sexual boundaries destroyed **at school**. As parents we need to fight back and hold our schools, and the education system, to account. I believe many schools present an active safeguarding risk to the very children they're charged with protecting.
